Re: Important Changes to the Hagan Scholarship

- a. ALL students attending public, private, charter, magnet, and STEM high schools can apply.
- b. The applicant's 2022 Adjusted Gross Household Income must not have exceeded \$100,000.

The Hagan Scholarship is a life-changing scholarship. The scholarship provides up to \$7,500 each semester for up to 8 consecutive semesters, providing recipients with the opportunity to graduate college debt-free. Recipients graduating college while in the Hagan Scholarship Program can apply to extend their scholarship for up to four additional semesters to attend graduate school.

Free workshops, Free Schwab Brokerage Accounts, and Free Study Abroad provide recipients with a practical understanding of important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum.

Hagan Scholarships awarded to date: 3,647

Colleges and Universities attended by Hagan Scholars: 514

Basic Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must graduate from a public, private, charter, magnet, or STEM high school
2. Must have achieved a 3.5 GPA
3. Must enroll in an eligible college or university the first semester following graduation
4. Must maintain a 4 year or less graduation schedule
5. Must work 240 hours prior to commencement of the fall semester in college
6. Applicants Adjusted Gross Household Income reported for 2022 Federal Income Tax Purposes must not have exceeded \$100,000.
