# Seminole High School Attendance Policy

A student who is absent without the principal's approval shall have their legal guardian report such absences to the school center. A written note must be presented to the front office to excuse student absence. **The note must come from a guardian listed in Skyward.**

**Parent Notes** will be accepted to excuse student absences that result from student illness (SCPS Student Code of Conduct) or from the list below.

1. Medical treatment provided by a licensed health professional-via official document. This includes, but not limited to, a doctor, orthodontist, dentist, chiropractor, psychologist, vision, etc.
2. Observance of religious practices or a religious holiday.
3. Law enforcement order or court subpoena-via subpoena document.
4. Death of an immediate family member-parent note will be accepted in this circumstance.
5. Traffic accident that directly involved the student-via accident report.
6. College visits for Junior and Seniors- 2 days per year via official document. (This does not include colleges that visit the SHS campus)
7. Parent notes explaining reason for absence, i.e. sick, doctor's appointment, family emergency.

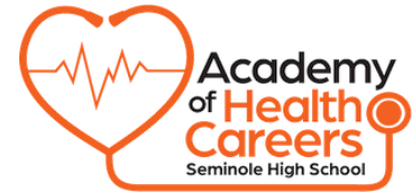

- The Pre-IB program has no grade point average, test score, or course prerequisite requirements to apply.
- Students can earn one of two diplomas: a Florida High School Diploma in the IB program and an IB Diploma (from the International Baccalaureate Organization in Switzerland).
- Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA and successfully complete core courses to remain in good standing in the Academy.



- Health Academy students all start with the Principles of Biomedical Science in the 9th grade.
- Students split into a patient care track or the biomedical track for coursework in grades 10-12.
